This list differs from that given by Manly and Rickert in the division of their Ox into Ox¹ and Ox², reflecting the physical separation of the parts of the manuscript. To² is the manuscript identified by Harris as containing extracts from Melibee and the Parson's Tale (p. 33 of *Manuscripts and Readers in Fifteenth-Century England: The Literary Implications of Manuscript Study*, ed. Derek Pearsall, 1983.) This necessitates renumbering of Manly and Rickert's To as To¹. Similarly, their Ds is renumbered Ds¹.
